- Qualifications:**
- * Must hold current 2008 VaHPA / NHPA membership card.
 - * All Players must have 3 sanctioned tournaments in the State of Virginia -----OR-----
2 tournaments and 1 Sanctioned League. PRIOR to signup cutoff date.
 - * Qualifying tournaments must be between August 9, 2007 and August 9, 2008.

Tournament Rules:

- * Entry fees: \$15.00 for adults and \$5.00 for juniors.
- * Check in 30 minutes prior to playing time.
- * Have your last name clearly visible on the back of your shirt. No tank tops, Shoes required.
- * Tournament play will begin at 9:00 am .
- * Pitchers pay scorekeepers \$1.00 per game (If no scorekeepers are available you must keep your own score)
- * Classes will be round robins, and dependent on the number of entries.
- * Format and class lineups will be decided by the Executive Council prior to the event. Changes can be made as necessary right up until class start time to accommodate no shows or drop outs.
- * Awards for 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- * Two separate sanctioned events: **Class Play/Qualify** and **Championships**

Class Play/Qualifying rounds:

- Separate classes for short distance and full distance pitchers..
- NaSTATs as of registration cutoff will be used to seed classes.
- 40 shoe limit all classes (if separate classes for Eld/W/Jr/Cadet mix require, shoe limit may be adjusted).
- Ties for 1st place (w/l) will be broken by a playoff game, ties for other placed awarded by percentage, then points

Championship rounds:

- All players must have pitched and completed class play/qualifying rounds.
- Final ringer percentage earned in class play/qualifying rounds will be used to seed classes.
- Number of Division classes determined by the Executive Council based on entries.
- Size of classes will be a pre-determined "invitational number" (10,8,6,4) determined by the Executive Council based on entries.
- 40 / 30 / 20 point limit all classes (if Jr/Cadet mixed classes, shoe/point limits may be set ie:20pts/30shoe)
If 40 point Games / cancellation The first pitcher to reach 40 points wins.
If 30 point Games / cancellation The first pitcher to reach 30 points wins.
If 20 point Games / cancellation The first pitcher to reach 20 points wins.
- Ties for 1st place (w/l) will be broken by a playoff game, ties for other placed awarded by percentage, then points.
- Ties in a shoe limit game (ie:20pts/30shoes) broken by 4 shoes down&back. Still tied, repeat until the tie is broken.
